**ADDRESS BY THE COLLEGE PRESIDENT**

Vice Presidents of the WACP, College officials, Fellow Fellows, and Members, I thank you all for participating in this extraordinary 44<sup>th</sup> and 45<sup>th</sup> AGSM of our College. Extraordinary in the fact that this is the very first virtual AGSM of our College, and you will all agree that it has exceeded our expectations and kudos to the Gambian Chapter and in particular Dr Uduak Okomo who led this venture.

This is just one example of the ways College has adapted to the unusual circumstances brought about by the covid 19 epidemic. Online meetings, virtual update courses and even virtual examinations have been adopted with the result that College activities have continued with little disruption.

Innovations such as the computer-based Testing have been implemented and College is striving to open more clinical examination centres for the ease of examiners and candidates alike. To this end more examiners are being trained and certified.

**LAGOS ACCOUNT: HIGHLIGHTS**

Please take note that the Forex rate adopted by the College for this account in 2020 was US\$1 = N460 compared to US\$1 = 380 in 2019.

There was a 13% decrease in the total income in the year under review; N 776,857,768 (US\$ 1,688,821.23) as compared to 890,959,617 (US\$ 2,344,630.57) in 2019.

Total expenditure decreased by 26.2% from N 766,951,989.00 (US\$ 2,018,294.71) in 2019 to N570,081,589 (US\$ 1,239,307.80) in 2020, compared to a marginal increase of 9.6% in the previous year.

The excess of income over expenditure in 2020 was N 205,681,606 (US\$ 447,133.93) compared to N 123,045,099.00 (US\$ 323,802.89) in 2019, an increase of 67.2% as compared to a 156% increase of the previous year.

Examinations fees including dissertation accounted for 39% of the total revenue in 2020, a gradual decrease from the previous years (44% in 2019).

Other sources of income for the year 2020 were:

Annual dues & Journal fees – N 117,952,024.00 (US\$ 256,417.44) ---15.2% of total revenue.

Physicians in Training fees – N 55,214,680 (US\$ 120,031.91) - - 7.1% of total revenue.

Accreditation and re-accreditation N 45,970,800 (US\$ 99,936.52) -5.9% of total revenue

Sales of College paraphernalia – N 44,192,485 (US\$ 96,070.61) – 5.7% of total revenue.

The College holds shares/stocks in companies through three Stock Brokerage firms. There was a slight increase of 5.9% in the market value from N 31,495,795.00 (US\$ 82,883.67) as at 31st Dec 2019 to N 33,359,980 (US\$ 72,521.70) in 2020.

#### COMMENTS ON FINANCIAL STATEMENTS - LAGOS

Our revenue from all sources increased by about 50% over this year mainly from examination fees and certain non-exam revenue like accreditation and reaccreditation, Physician in training fees and sales of College paraphernalia. Issue of transcripts is emerging as a significant source of income because of the exodus of Nigerian doctors to the diaspora.

About 50% of the income was expended in the year under review compared to 74% last year.

Revenue from examinations has reduced drastically because of the high inflation of good and items in the country consequent upon the remarkable increase in exchange rate of the dollar to the naira. In addition, items purchased for the prevention of Covid 19 during the exams has added to the expenditure.

### **COMMENTS ON FINANCIAL STATEMENTS - ACCRA**

The account in Accra is mainly an exam account but exemption fees contributed significantly to the overall income in the year under review. A reduction in the total expenditure, because of reduction of administrative expenditure from prudent management resulted in Accra continuing to make appreciable profit.

### **CHAPTER ACCOUNTS**

The usual practice is for Chapter Treasurers to submit their audited accounts to the College before the AGSM.

Both GHANA & NIGERIA Chapters have submitted their audited accounts to the College. The accounts showed that the Chapters have a healthy financial situation as at end of 2020. The College's share of annual dues has been calculated and Nigeria is up to date while Ghana is yet to respond.

Other Chapters usually present their accounts and College share of Chapter dues at the AGSM. It is only Benin Republic and Liberia that have done so, still expecting from other Chapters.

- (4) Ratified recommendation of EXCO to generate a unique number for all Fellows of the College and members of the College, members would continue with their unique number the must have passed their Fellowship examination
- (5) Post membership certificate holders to pay 500 dollars building fund and pay the remaining 500 dollars after fellowship, all to be paid in instalments, all requesting for transcript to pay 250 dollars for members and 500 dollars for fellows.
- (6) Registration and payment for physicians – in – training fee to be paid at most one year before writing membership exams.
- (7) Exemption fee to be sustained at 700 dollars to encourage candidates to write college primaries.
- (8) Primary exam fee to be reduced to 150 dollars to encourage more candidates to write our primary.
- (9) Abuja town building design to change existing structure of three rooms per wing to five rooms per wing.  
College to get a retainership arrangement with a lawyer based where the secretariat is based
- (10) To sustain the WAJM, F&GPC recommended that SG to continue negotiations with WACS for a possible complete takeover of the journal publications since the WACS have their own journal
- (11) Add Endowment funds to BOT account
- (12) Expiring prizes to have donors contacted to raise endowment to 2,000USD

The recommendations from BOT were adopted by Dr. B.S.C Uzochukwu and seconded by Dr Simeon Uriah.

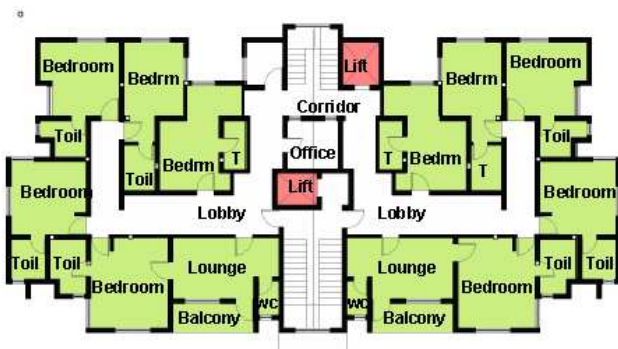

#### COMMUNIQUE

#### **PREAMBLE**

- The 44th & 45th Annual General and Scientific Meeting of the West African College of Physicians, hosted by The Gambia chapter, was held virtually, from 1st-3rd November, using Kenes Group platform
- The Minister of Health of The Gambia, **Dr Ahmadou Lamin Samateh**, the Director of Africa CDC, **Dr John Nkengasong** delivered their speeches at the opening ceremony
- Sister Colleges delivered their goodwill messages
- **His Excellency Adama Barrow The President of The Gambia** officially launched the meeting on Monday 1st November 2021
- The Theme of the Conference: « Universal Health Coverage : “**a right for everyone, everywhere** “ and the scientific tracks were : Universal healthcare, Age-related healthcare, Vaccines, Mental health, Epidemic and pandemic healthcare
- **1,447 delegates across 5 continents from 24 countries:** Australia, Belgium, Benin, Burkina Faso, Canada, Congo (Brazzaville), Cote d'Ivoire, Ethiopia, France, the Gambia, Ghana, Kenya, Lesotho, Liberia, Malawi, Mali, Nigeria, Saudi Arabia, Senegal, Sierra Leone, South Africa, Togo, United Kingdom and The United States of America.
- The academic activities of the meeting included the following
  - **The Mabayoje College Lecture**, titled « Attaining SDG3 Maternal, Newborn and child Health related targets in West Africa: Challenges of inequities and inequalities - **Professor Angela Okolo** on behalf of the Faculty of Paediatrics



- **The Annual College Symposium** featuring: « Universal Health Care: Beyond the Slogan » was presented by Faculty of Family Medicine. Topics covered included: Universal health Coverage in the post-COVID-19 era, Improving health indices through strengthening primary care, Challenges and prospects of accessibility to essential health services.
  - **A Vaccinology Symposium** - New Developments in Vaccinology in West Africa with the following topics: Vaccine science at MRC Gambia and with West-African Partnerships, New vaccines against meningitis and pneumonia in West Africa, Vaccinating pregnant women to protect their babies- example of RSV, Vaccine Confidence in West Africa – do we need to be concerned, and gaps in Vaccine coverage in West Africa
  - **A Mental Health Symposium** - Mental Health Awareness and Combating Stigma with the following topics: Mental Health of children and adolescents, Mental health policy and practice in the sub-region, The person behind the white coat: work and mental health among doctors in the sub-region, Grandmothers treating depression: lessons from the Friendship Bench Zimbabwe; and Mental Health Advocacy in Nigeria: a case study on how the lessons from the past can change the future
  - SARS-CoV-2 (COVID) Symposium: Successes and Challenges – The Africa Experience with the following presentation : Clinical trials for SARS-CoV-2 vaccines on the African continent, Challenges and lessons from SARS-CoV-2, Development of SARS-CoV-2 rapid antigen test and plans for vaccine production in Senegal, Seroprevalence of SARS-CoV-2 in Africa and immunity induced by natural infection, and Equity in vaccine access.
  - A Special and very appreciated session for Young Fellows and Members , that discussed on Life After Residency Training: Developing a Career in Clinical Research. The topics covered were : The need for clinician scientists in healthcare and research, Training and Mentorship for a Research Career, Attracting funding for research in West Africa, How West African Clinician-Scientists can Bridge the Research-to-Publication Gap.
- There were scientific sessions in which 105 oral (32) and poster (73) presentations form abstracts relevant to the theme and subthemes were made. In addition there were 20 symposium presentations and four (4) targeted to Members and young Fellows of the College.
  - **430 new fellows and 449 new members** in the medical specialties of Community Medicine, Family Medicine, Internal Medicine, Laboratory Medicine, Paediatrics & Psychiatry were inducted at the ceremony opening.
  - 07 new members and 04 new Fellows were also inducted at the closing ceremony

## OBSERVATIONS

- Almost all the West African countries are far from attaining the SDG3 which is mainly related to UHC, including financial risk protection, access to quality essential healthcare services and access to safe, effective, quality and affordable essential medicines, and vaccines for all.
- Maternal and under-five mortality ratios in West African countries remain high with as root causes: poverty (95% of maternal deaths occur in LMIC), inequities in health and avoidable health inequalities occasioned by adverse social, cultural and economic influences and policies, underutilization of health services, low coverage of share of births attended (SBA) skilled staff, weak reference and feedback system, limited funding for health in the sub-region



- There is abysmal level of health coverage of West African citizens with a double burden of disease, poor access to care and poor health outcomes, many years after the launch of Social Health Insurance Scheme in the sub-region
- Imbalance in health investments at different levels of the health system: 70% of the financing goes to tertiary level while almost 80% of the load work in health is managed at PHC level
- COVID-19 pandemic has disrupted the delivery of essential healthcare services, worsened by existing health inequities, fragile healthcare systems, persistent supply issues (98% of medicines, vaccines and other healthcare commodities in Africa are imported)
- Vaccine confidence seems low in the region with high vaccine hesitancy for participating to vaccine trials in the context of misinformation widespread through social media
- There is a gap in vaccine coverage in the region towards the immunisation 2030 agenda with differences across countries, equity gaps (urban vs rural, maternal education, wealth difference)
- There is lack of scientific data generated on the African continent and this has been again highlighted by the current pandemic, mainly because lack of committed leadership and adequate funding
- Poor governance structure for mental health in west Africa as shown by lack of mental health policy and strategic plans in most of west Africa countries

## **RECOMMENDATIONS:**

### **Recommendations to Governments and other stakeholders**

- Governments should invest in quality primary care as it is the cornerstone to achieving Universal Health Coverage
- Governments should strengthen primary care at the level of the primary care provider by providing adequate training and capacity building, and redesigning the health system to make it patient & family-centred, community-oriented and team-based with multisectoral collaboration (public-private, alternate medicine), and monitoring and evaluation
- Governments should strengthen physician led PHC/Health system and improve the Human Resources in Health Development plans
- Governments and other stakeholders should promote research in Health in sub-region by building capacity and providing adequate resources
- Governments should build capacity and infrastructures for local manufacturing of essential medicines and vaccines in Africa.
- Governments and other stakeholders should continue to raise awareness about the current COVID-19 pandemic and the need for all to get vaccinated.
- Governments should improve political will and prioritise mental health, as there is no health without mental health as preached by the UN/WHO

### **Recommendations to College**

- The College should encourage, in their advisory capacity, WAHO and the Governments of West Africa to:
  - accelerate attainment of SDG 3 through ensuring adherence to Abuja declaration for increase in health budget to the level of 15% of national budget.
  - tackle poverty elimination and address gender equity in communities of West Africa.





- strengthen the health system and in particular, the primary health care system and the community sub systems.
- The College should explore further means of collaboration with Governments to support work force development and health coverage for hard-to-reach communities through capacity building and collaboration with country governments towards increasing the number of specialists to address the needs.
- The College should advocate consistently governments at all levels as well as the informal sector to engage in Universal Health Coverage
- The College through chapters and faculties should intensify communication towards populations to overcome vaccine hesitancy

## **RESOLUTIONS**

**That the West African College of Physicians is committed to:**

- 1. Assisting the governments of the Sub-region to accelerate attainment of SDG 3 through Universal Health Coverage across the subregion**
- 2. Providing the expertise of its members to governments to put in place a resilient and quality primary care health system**
- 3. Assisting the governments in building strong research capacities across the sub-region**
- 4. Assisting the governments of the sub-region to build capacity for local manufacturing of essential medicines and vaccines in the sub-region**
- 5. Partnering with organizations such as WAHO and countries to develop and implement mental health policies and strategies for qualitative mental health promotion, mental illness prevention and interventions in the sub region**
