



DEFINITION

INTENTIONAL ACTION- DELIBERATE IN BOTH ACTION AND WORDS. (UNDERSTANDING WHAT YOU WANT BEFORE STARTING A TASK OR OPENING COMMUNICATION)



BENEFITS

ESTABLISH REALISTIC GOALS AND OUTCOMES.

CREATE A ROBUST COMMUNICATION FRAMEWORK.

TO MANAGE RESOURCES EFFECTIVELY.

ANALYSE SITUATIONS OBJECTIVELY AND SECURE THE FUTURE.

- WHEN WE DEVELOP STRATEGIC SKILLS, THE FOLLOWING ARE ACHIEVED.
- **1. PROCATIVE NOT REACTIVE**
- 2. INTENTIONAL NOT DEPENDING ON "LUCK".
- 3. IMPROVE ON THE SYSTEM AND SECURE IT FOR THE FUTURE.
- 4. FOCUS ON THE RIGHT THINGS NOT EVERYTHING
