



# What is Assessment?

- The **systematic, evidence-based** process of evaluating a learner's knowledge, skills, professional behaviours, and readiness for advanced practice using a variety of validated methods.
- It is designed not only to measure competence against predefined standards, but also to support learning, ensure accountability, and make high-stakes decisions about progression, certification, and professional independence.
- Typically, it is a continuous, programmatic, workplace-integrated, and criterion-referenced, emphasizing real-world performance, professional judgment, and alignment with the competencies required for safe, effective, and autonomous practice.

- ▶ Effective postgraduate assessment is built on the foundation of defensible standards —
    - ▶ Clear
    - ▶ transparent thresholds that define what competent performance looks like
    - ▶ Fair
    - ▶ Ensure that such assessments truly reflect the knowledge, skills, and judgment required for advanced professional practice
